Vacancy for a Debt Centre Manager

Sale CAP (Christians Against Poverty) Debt Centre, which is run by six churches in Sale, is seeking to appoint a Debt Centre Manager to lead the Centre and work. The Debt Centre Manager will be employed for 3 days per week, which could be worked flexibly, focused on supporting individuals and families in the Sale (M33) area who have contacted CAP for debt help. The Centre Manager will undertake home visits, gather paperwork and communicate advice prepared by CAP's debt advisors. The Centre Manager will also oversee the CAP Debt Coach working in Partington, and will also be responsible for building relationships with statutory, voluntary and community referral organisations locally; work closely to promote the Debt Centre and the work of CAP across the local churches and build and develop a team of volunteer befrienders who currently support the work in Sale.

We are looking for someone who is passionate about supporting those in need and who has a heart for sharing their Christian faith with others.
